

MATHER VETERAN'S VILLAGE

PHASE I



DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

Mather Veteran's Village was the first of three phases of critically needed veteran housing with supportive services located on the former Mather Air Force base in Rancho Cordova, California.

This 42,000 sq. ft. project includes 50 residential units and occupies the southwest section of the site. The building is a "C" shaped, 3-story building that wraps around a shared green space and courtyard. All of the units are connected by an elevator-accessed walkway that also serves as a shared balcony.

Onsite amenities include community room with kitchen and lounge area, as well laundry facilities and computer lab.
