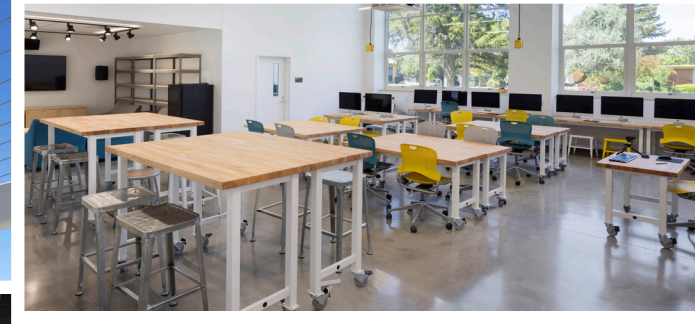


UC DAVIS CRUESS HALL RENOVATION
