Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Oversee construction projects from beginning-to-end, i.e., pre-construction to post-construction.
- Obtains, maintains, and manages data, information, communications, and approvals required by project and company requirements between owner, architects, engineers, and other project-related entities.
- Schedule and host OAC meetings.



- Ensures contracts, drawings, estimates, and specifications comply with construction/project requirements.
- Manage the project budget and cost estimates.
- Assist in the mobilization and pre-construction phase of a project.
- Determine the necessary equipment, materials, and manpower needed, and keep track of inventory, tools, and equipment.
- Procure supplies and materials timely, which requires monitoring of supply chains and lead times.
- Build and manage construction schedule in P6 including Time Impact Analysis preparation and submission.
- Prepare reports regarding job status and safety protocols, as applicable.
- Solve challenges or problems that may arise before, during or after construction.
- Ensure compliance with safety regulations and building codes.
- Train and mentor project engineers.
- Collaborate with trade partners, engineers, architects, and key team members of the project team.
- Negotiate with external vendors on contract agreements.
- Obtain the appropriate permits and licenses from authorities for construction sites.
- Plan construction operations.
- Ensure all deadlines are met.
- Delegate and manage responsibilities for project-related tasks.
- Allocate and manage resources to ensure that they are available when they are needed throughout the construction projects.
- Keep all stakeholders aware of the progress on projects and prepare progress reports regularly.
- Conduct site checks to monitor progress and quality standards.
